Paul makes discipleship simple and attainable 1 Thessalonians 2:1-12. He modeled a repeatable model for discipleship with four essential elements. 1) Establish a Relationship of Care, 2) Share what you know about Jesus, 3) Model Godliness with your life, & 4) Speak boldly into their life.

1. Start w/ a relationship of care.

*During your time together seek to identify & establish a hunger to know God.

*Establish a beginning and end time (ex: weekly or twice a month for 1 year).

2. Share what you know about Jesus.

*Share the story of your journey with Jesus.

*What seasons/stages have you gone through in your spiritual journey?

3. Model Godliness with your life.

* Teach them to pray; how to have a conversation with God where your life & God meet. Have times of upward (praise/adoration), outward (to see the needs of others and your community), and inward prayer (confession, repentance, help, and guidance).

• Share real requests with one another and commit to pray for one another.

4. Speak Boldly into their lives.

- Understanding God's grace and growing in God's Grace. This will include scriptural & historical examples as well as personal reflections on God's Grace to us each day.
- Identifying Sin and Idols while growing in their identity in Christ. Learning what repentance is, and how to repent and believe.
