## Acts 2:14-36

Peter’s Sermon at Pentecost was rich with the Gospel message. It was that day that everything changed for the church. They went from a few hundred huddled in a single room to a movement of thousands.

This week’s bible text and Sundays Message is all about the Gospel. Our hope this week is that your conversation will be rich with discussion about the Good News we have in Jesus. For this reason, we have designed the guide a bit different than you generally see.

**Step 1:** Discuss anything that stands out to you

**Step 2:** What does this passage say about God and His character?

**There is a strong emphasis on the Gospel here, don’t miss a chance to discuss it. Try to get your group to name three characteristics that are apparent.**

**Step 3:** What does this passage say about us and our need?
