Acts 18:18-28

**Big Idea:** As Christians we are not called to criticize from afar but rather to disciple and develop others up close.

- 2. Apollos had a very impactful ministry even though he still had things to learn. Has God ever used you in a way that you felt unequipped for?
- 3. Apollos was willing to be pulled aside and have the truths of Scripture explained "more accurately." This took some humility.
  - a) What role does humility play in our faith?
  - b) What happens when there is a lack of humility?
- 4. Priscilla and Aquila are a model of hospitality, mentoring and faithfulness.
  - a) Which of these characteristics do you value most?
  - b) Which would you like to improve on?
