- Theme Overview - We want you to be in the loop to start and continue these conversations at home. This explains the focus for each day at camp.
- Packing List - I would add a journal, closed toed shoes, and a water bottle. **Phones will only be allowed if they are turned in at check in and used during designated times** each day. No gaming devices. The cost for every meal except the first is included, so you won't need to send students with money for meals unless they want to eat at Chick-fil-a. **Your student will need to bring a sack lunch for the first day.**
- Daily Schedule - We are using the "Connect" option mentioned in the schedule. "One More Thing" on nights 2 and 3 will be optional. Encourage your student to sleep at camp, it helps. **Check In starts at 8:00am on the 24th and we will leave the church at 9:00am. We plan to return by 4:30pm on the 28th.**
- Special Needs Request - If your student has a disability or food allergy we need to be made aware of, please turn this in ASAP so we can work with Generate to accommodate.
- Camp Bucks - Camp Bucks are gift cards that friends and family can purchase online to send to their camper while they are away at camp. Camp Bucks can be purchased now through the third day of camp and can be used at the Generate store to purchase T-shirts, hoodies, hats, books, and more
