- Learn and use Northeast's preferred worship tools (backing tracks, click tracks, in-ear monitors, digital charts, etc.)
- Cultivate a heart of worship outside of rehearsals and Sunday services

QUALIFICATIONS

- Faith in Jesus Christ and membership at Northeast Bible Church
- Vocal and vocal blending ability (vocal assessment required)
- Ability to harmonize and "hear" parts
- Humble and flexible
- Actively pursuing a relationship with God offstage
- Teachable spirit, ready to follow the leading of the Worship Arts Director and Music Director, and willingness to be developed and coached
- Willing to serve 2 hours on Wednesdays and 5 hours on Sundays when scheduled
