- Supervise each child's safety
- Communicate with other FAST Childcare Volunteers, FAST leadership, and FAST families
- Keep FAST families in your prayers outside of meeting days

- A heart for serving kids, especially the orphan
- A positive and friendly attitude
- Able to pass a volunteer background check
- Willing to serve at least once a month during FAST meetings (typically two hours, from 6:15-8:15p on the second Wednesday of every month)
